An entrance exam will be held Sunday, October 21, 2018 at 2:pm, in the Forest Hill Civic and Convention Center, located at 6901 Wichita Street, Forest Hill, TX 76140. Candidates interested in taking the entrance examination must have the Job Qualification Questionnaire and all required documents submitted to the Civil Service Director located at 3219 California Parkway, by **Thursday October 18, 2018 no later than 5:00 pm**. Seating is limited and submissions of all required documents are required to reserve a seat. Civil Service regulations will apply.

There is a Personal History Statement associated with the link below. This will need to be completed in its entirety and turned in Sunday October 21, 2018 at the test site or you will not be allowed to take the test.

Job Requirements:

- Education: TCOLE Peace Officer Certification Preferred.
- Candidates must possess a High School Diploma or General Equivalency Diploma.
- Minimum age requirement – 21 years of age; (per Texas Local Government Code, Chapter 143.023, a person 45 years of or older may not be certified as eligible for a beginning position in a Civil Service governed Police Department).
- Upon successful completion of the written examination, candidates will be expected to participate in and pass a thorough background investigation, an oral board examination, and an interview with the Chief of Police. Candidates will also be expected to pass a polygraph examination and qualifying psychological exam and will be expected to participate in and pass a qualifying physical agility and medical examination, including drug testing.
- Must be a United States citizen
