

Driver Safety Course

If you have been charged with an offense under Subtitle C, Rules of the Road you may request to have your citation dismissed by pleading "no contest" or "guilty," paying court costs and a nonrefundable administrative fee of at least \$114.00 and completing a driving safety course approved by the Texas Education Agency (TEA).

To be eligible for driving safety, the following requirements must be met:

- Must not have completed a driving safety course to dismiss a citation within the last 12 months or be in the process of taking the course for another traffic violation
- A speeding violation must not exceed the posted speed limit by more than 24 MPH
- Must be at least 17 years old
- Must possess a valid Texas driver's license or military ID (that is not classified as a commercial driver's license CDL)
- Must present current personal proof of liability insurance in your name or listing your name as a covered driver
- Violation did not occur in a construction zone with workers present
- Violation did not occur while passing a school bus

If you meet the above requirements you may request to take a driving safety course before the court by the appearance date on your citation.

You may make the request in person, by mail, or by faxing the request to 817-984-8254.

To apply by mail or fax please download the form **REQUEST FOR DRIVER SAFETY COURSE** form and mail it to the Court along with a copy of your valid Texas Driver's License, proof of valid insurance and a check or money order in the amount of \$114.00. If the offense happened in a school zone the amount due is \$139.00.
