

PARKING CITATIONS

A parking citation may be issued to the registered owner of the vehicle if the driver of the vehicle is not present at the time the citation is issued.

If you want to challenge your parking citation, you must appear in person at the Municipal Court office and present a valid photo ID such as your driver’s license or a state issued identification card to request a hearing. The Hearing will not be held that day it will be scheduled for a later date. The case will be placed on the Pre Trial Docket so that you may speak with the City Prosecutor.

If you cannot reach an agreement with the City Prosecutor you will have the option to request a trial.

You No Longer Own This Vehicle

If you no longer own the vehicle you must provide legal documentation to the court such as a bill of sale, title, or transfer of title in order for the court to take the appropriate action.
